

Mullica Township School District
District Provided Technology Device Form for Students in Grades 5 - 8
 Student/Parent Agreement 2017-18

For the 2017-18 school year, the Mullica Township School District is implementing a 1:1 Chromebook initiative with all students in grades 5-8. The Chromebook is intended to be used for school related purposes only and should be handled with care. The District is also providing GoGuardian security, an education focused software for device management and web filtering, on all Chromebooks. A nonrefundable auxiliary usage fee of \$10 is required on or before taking possession of the Chromebook. In addition to the provisions of the Mullica Township School District Acceptable Use Agreement, the following items apply to students participating in the one-to-one Chromebook program.

Once possession of the Chromebook has been taken, you will comply at all times with the Mullica Township School District Technology Acceptable Use Policy, Internet Rules, and accept responsibility for the reasonable care according Chromebook Care Guidelines. The Chromebook may record or collect information on the student's activity or use of the device, however, under no circumstances will privacy be violated with the device, as per New Jersey's Anti-Big Brother Act (A2932/S2057).

Your right to use and possession of the property terminates not later than the last day of the school year unless terminated earlier by the District or upon withdrawal from the District. The signatory is responsible to return the property in good working order, except for reasonable wear and tear.

1. All policies and provisions of the Acceptable Use Policy must be followed.
2. Students will be certain that Chromebooks are recharged daily and have a fully charged battery each morning.
3. Students will use their Chromebooks at school only for school-related purposes.
4. Students will keep their Chromebooks clean with no attached stickers, no writing, or other items that might deface or damage the Chromebook finish, screen or other components.
5. Students are expected to keep their login passwords private. If a student feels their password becomes known for any reason they should immediately notify their homeroom teacher.
6. No loaning or borrowing of Chromebooks between students is allowed under any circumstances.
7. Students will immediately report all malfunctions, damage, loss, or theft of their Chromebook computer to their homeroom teacher or building principal.
8. Although the District's content filter and Internet safety plan is in place, students are expected to notify a staff member whenever they come across information or messages that are inappropriate, threatening, or make them feel uncomfortable.
9. Students will transport their Chromebooks in a secure manner (backpack) and will store them in secure locations when not using them.
10. The District will impose a "zero tolerance" policy for Chromebook damage, accidental or otherwise. **All** repairs for Chromebook damage will be charged back to the parent/guardian. To minimize the possibility of accidental Chromebook damage, the District encourages students/parents to cover their Chromebook with a plastic case. The chart below outlines the most common repair costs.
