Pre-Kindergarten Pacing Chart Students have Spanish once every 7 days for the entire school year.

The Mullica Township School District offers Spanish instruction beginning in Pre K and continuing to Grade 8. Each year's instruction builds upon and extends instruction from prior years. Spanish instruction for Grades Pre K to Grade Four (Novice level) and in Grades Five through Eight (Mid level), is offered on A/B rotation schedule.

Students learn to communicate *using memorized words and phrases* to talk about familiar topics related to school, home, and community. When students graduate Mullica Township School, they will be prepared for Spanish instruction at the proficiency level of Novice-High in high school.

By the end of Kindergarten, Pre K and Kindergarten students will understand and communicate the following: colors, counting numbers through 10, and shapes. In addition, students will experience a Three Kings Day unit.

By the end of Grade Two, students will understand and communicate the following: numbers through 20, counting by tens to 30, names of animals, and expressions of feelings. In addition, students will experience a Las Posadas unit.

By the end of Grade Four, students will understand and communicate the following: numbers through 100, greetings, and body parts. In addition, students will experience a Las Posadas unit.

By the end of Grade Eight, students will understand and communicate all prior vocabulary. In addition, students will experience the following units: Leave-taking Expressions and Greetings; Las Parrandas; and Conversational Spanish.
